Andrew Williams obtained his BSc and PhD at the University of Western Australia in 2010, followed by postdoctoral positions at Oxford University and the University of Copenhagen. He was appointed Assistant Professor in the Department of Veterinary Disease Biology, University of Copenhagen, in 2015, and Associate Professor in 2017. His current work focuses on gastrointestinal helminths, mainly the swine parasites Trichuris suis and Ascaris suum. Particular areas of interest are host immunity and inflammation, and interactions between infection and host diet/microbiome and metabolic function.
