The major research activity of Dr Ingrid Felger is field-based molecular epidemiology of malaria parasites. Molecular parameters are developed to describe parasite population genetics, transmission dynamics and survival of individual parasite clones in the host. Dr Felger's research is conducted within worldwide collaborations in Africa, Asia, Oceania and Brazil. Previously she has worked at the Papua New Guinea Institute of Medical Research (1991-1994). Since 1996 Dr Felger is employee of the Swiss Tropical & Public Health Institute, Basel, Switzerland as Head of the Molecular Diagnostics unit, where she has been leading the development of new tests for a variety of infectious diseases, which are applied for individual diagnosis as well as population-wide studies.
