Dr. Alok Bhattacharya is currently a professor in the Schools of Life Sciences & Computation and Integrative Sciences at Jawaharlal Nehru University. He obtained a Master's degree in Chemistry from IIT Kanpur and Ph.D. in "Life Sciences" from Jawaharlal Nehru University. He carried out post-doctoral work at National Cancer Institute and Harvard Medical School, USA. After returning back to India he spent a few years at AIIMS, New Delhi and Tata Research Development & Design Centre, Pune before joining JNU as an associate professor. Initially he set up a lab to carry out research in Immunology and infectious diseases, particularly understanding immune response to pathogens at the molecular level. Later he developed a research program on "Amoebiasis" an intestinal disease highly endemic in India and one of the neglected tropical diseases. He had also setup one of the first teaching and research programs on Bioinformatics and Computation Biology in India.
