Shin-ichiro Kawazu is a Professor of Advanced Preventive Medicine in the National Research Center for Protozoan Diseases at Obihiro University of Agriculture and Veterinary Medicine. He graduated from Kitasato University, School of Veterinary Medicine in Japan with DVM. He received PhD degree in Veterinary Medicine on classification of benign *Theileria* species in cattle from Hokkaido University in 1993. The current approach in his group is the development and application of genetically modified *Babesia* parasite for investigating host-parasite interaction in this parasites species.
