Benjamin Mordmüller acts as the Deputy Director of the Institute of Tropical Medicine Tübingen and the Center for Clinical Trials at the University Clinics Tübingen. The aim of his work is the discovery and development of new medicines for infectious diseases through theoretical, biochemical, and clinical research. His research focusses on tropical medicine, particularly malaria. Besides projects on the prevention, treatment and pathophysiology of malaria, he designed and performed pivotal studies to standardize controlled human malaria infection and immunization with cryopreserved sporozoites. Current projects include studies on the development of sporozoite-based and asexual blood stage vaccines, novel drugs and naturally acquired immunity.
