Prof. Dr. Eliézer K. N'Goran is from the Université Félix Houphouët Boigny-Abidjan in Côte d'Ivoire. He is currently the head of the department of Zoology and animal Biology and the unit of parasitology, and parasite ecology in the Biosciences faculty. Since the 1990 he actively pursue research, teaching and training. The main activities of his group are epidemiology, ecology, clinical research on drug effectiveness and efficiency and public health issues of human schistosomiasis and geohelminthiases, but also focusses on participating in clinical trials in Côte d'Ivoire. He successfully conduct as Investigator coordinator the Phase II clinical Trial on pediatric formulatium of Praziquantel in Côte d'Ivoire. He has published more than 100 manuscripts, original articles and reviews on schistosomiasis research in the peer-reviewed literature, including major interdisciplinary journals and in the top tire of specialized journals in parasitology and tropical medicine. He is member of the Ivorian Society of Parasitology and of the WHO Country Support Group for the Control of Neglected Tropical Diseases of the WHO African Region. He chairs the Ethics Committee of the Swiss Center for Scientific Research in Abidjan and the International Network of Schistosomiasis, Environments and control (RISEAL International).
