Dr. Hyeong-Kyu Jeon is an Invited Professor in the Department of Parasitology, Medical Research Institute, Chungbuk National University School of Medicine, Korea. He did his Master of Science in Microbiology and subsequently finished PhD in Parasitology from Chungbuk National University, Korea followed by a postdoctoral training in Parasitology in the same institute supported by a grant of National Research Foundation of Korea (NRF). He has been working on cestodes including taxonomical classification, morphology, phylogenetics, mitochondrial genomics and epidemiology of *Taenia*, *Diphyllobothrium* and *Spirometra* species tapeworms. His current research focuses on the classification of *Spirometra* species inducing human sparganosis including geographical distribution, genetic identification and epidemiological major questions. He is an editorial board member of BioMed Research International and Korean Journal of Parasitology. He has taken a part in Scientific Program Committee COPA 2018 held in Daegu, Korea.
